


12 NEW ORGANIZATIONS JOIN THE WELCOME CORPS TO HELP SPONSOR REFUGEES

LOS ANGELES, Dec. 17, 2024–Today, 12 organizations joined the Welcome Corps as Private Sponsor Organizations These groups will help Home for Refugees recruit and support volunteers to sponsor refugees through the program. The program will help and guide volunteers in giving essential services, building relationships with local community groups, and supporting refugees throughout the process.

"Home for Refugees USA mission is to create opportunities for the community to help their new refugee neighbors to rebuild their lives in their new homes. We have seen, since 2016 when our work began during the Syrian refugee crisis, how refugees revitalize communities through the mutual, transformational friendships they form with their volunteer Private Sponsor Group. Thanks to Welcome Corps and the introduction of private sponsorship of refugees, the future of resettlement in the United States has arrived. Home for Refugees is excited to join this new welcoming movement to help more refugees achieve safety, freedom, and dignity." said **Minda Schweizer, Executive Director of Home for Refugees USA**.

Through the Welcome Corps, eligible U.S. citizens and permanent residents work in teams of five or more to assist refugees resettling under the U.S. Refugee Admissions Program (USRAP). Refugees will receive support with securing housing, welcoming refugees at the airport, enrolling children in school, helping adults to find jobs, and getting driver's licenses.

The Welcome Corps is a U.S. government community service program that launched in January 2023. It allows people to sponsor refugees from around the world. It is the most significant innovation in U.S. refugee resettlement in over 40 years. The program is implemented by six organizations with expertise in refugee resettlement and integration, led by the Community Sponsorship Hub. The Welcome Corps aims to mobilize at least 10,000 U.S. volunteers in 2023 to support refugees through private sponsorship.
